

VKMLA Player Release Procedure

Player releases to other associations are granted as a last resort and only in extraordinary situations (e.g., no team at an appropriate level in the “home” association).

It is the player’s/family’s responsibility to make sure that the procedure is followed.

1. Any player requesting a release from the home association **MUST** first register with the home association. There are NO exceptions allowed. Registration can be completed at www.vancouverlacrosse.com (open by early January) and any questions regarding registration should be directed towards the registrar, registrar@vancouverlacrosse.com. If a release is granted, the released player will be granted a full refund.
2. Players requesting a release **MUST** apply in writing (email to any executive member is fine) by **March 1st** of the current playing year. This application must include the “BCLA Player Release Form” that is available from the BCLA website (www.bclacrosse.com) or by contacting the BCLA directly (604-421-9755).
3. NO release will be signed by the home association until **AFTER** the Lower Mainland Minor Lacrosse Commission’s team declaration meeting (second Monday of March).
4. NO release will be signed/granted until **AFTER March 31st** of the current playing year if the above deadlines are not respected.
